People Powered Fair Maps™ is a statewide redistricting campaign of the League of Women Voters of Oregon focused on creating fair political maps in Oregon.

We believe Oregon voters should choose their politicians—politicians should not get to choose their voters.

We're working on a statewide campaign to pass a redistricting ballot measure in 2020. Our proposal:

- Creates a fair system so voters are choosing their politicians, instead of politicians choosing their voters.
- Gives Oregonians balanced leadership, focused on equal representation.
- Provides a greater opportunity for underrepresented communities to have a voice in their representation.

This campaign is all about building and sharing power across communities.

As the 2020 census approaches, Oregon's population growth is likely to result in the addition of a sixth congressional district. To make sure new district boundaries are fair, we need to turn the redistricting process over to impartial citizens and take the partisan politics out of the process.

We're working to ensure redistricting plans designed after the census in 2021 are free, fair, and accessible.

Together, we will make lasting change—and ensure our democracy realizes its promise of one person, one vote.
